



Borrower's Card vs. E-Card

You can get a free Wichita Public Library card at an seven of our locations. There are two types of cards you can register for:

A **BORROWER'S CARD** lets you access all digital library resources online as well as check out physical materials from all Wichita Public Library locations, like books and DVDs.

An **E-CARD** gives you complete access to digital library services and access to technology. Students can read e-books, listen to e-audiobooks, use library computers and Wi-Fi, and read book chapters and articles from magazines online. They can also Book-A-Librarian for one-on-one help at library locations, as well as access 3D printing services at the Advanced Learning Library.

*Customers age 17 and younger need an adult to get a library card. The signing adult will be responsible for all items checked out on the card as well as what is accessed on the internet. Minors may use the identification of the signing adult for address verification.
